

# MATHS WEEK LONDON

## School Activity Grant Application

### Background

The Mayor's Fund for London is excited to be a partner of the first ever Maths Week London! Taking place from 10<sup>th</sup>-14<sup>th</sup> June 2019, the mission of Maths Week London is to raise the profile of maths in the London community, improving children's attitude towards maths and promoting the value of maths as an essential skill.

Throughout Maths Week there will be events, activities and competitions happening across the city, and lots of free and fun resources available to download from their website for schools and parents. To support and encourage schools to run their own activities and events during Maths Week, the Mayor's Fund for London is running a small grants scheme on behalf of Maths Week London for London-based schools to access.

### Development Grants and Selection Criteria

Maths Week London activity grants are available to **London schools** in order for them to purchase any resources or equipment they may need to run an event or specific activities during Maths Week London. Each school has the opportunity to bid for up to £250. Schools will be expected to set out what resources they need and the cost of these resources. As a social mobility charity, the Mayor's Fund focuses on those children who are most in need. To be eligible to access this support funding schools must be located in a London borough, and have higher than average pupils on free school meals or be situated in an area of deprivation.

### Monitoring information

Schools will be required to will write and submit a short case study about the events and activities held and, where possible, invite a member of the Mayor's Fund team to attend.

### How to complete this application form
